Young Artist Competition

February 4, 2019

The LSO Young Artist Competition is scheduled for February 4, 2019. The competition begins at 7:00p.m. You will be notified of your audition time after the application deadline. The location will be in the Forbis Recital Hall in the Pillsbury Music Center at William Jewell College. Practice rooms are on the 100-level of Pillsbury.

Eligibility

Contestants must be residents of Missouri or Kansas and must not have won the competition in previous years. Open to public and private school and homeschool pianists, orchestral/band instrumentalists, and vocalists currently in middle through high school (6th – 12th grade).

Music

Music selected for the competition must have an orchestral accompaniment available for purchase or rental in the United States. Check the following online resources: Luck's Music Library, Kalmus, Boosey & Hawkes, G. Schirmer, and European American Music.

Performance Selection

Instrumentalists should choose one movement or solo work not to exceed 10-15 minutes. Vocalists should choose a song or aria not to exceed 10 minutes. Contestants must audition on the piece or song they intend to perform with the orchestra.

Memory

Performances need to be memorized. The audition must be performed in person with an accompanist hired by the contestant. Both audition and performance must be memorized.

Competition

The competition will take place in the Forbis Recital Hall (3rd floor) in Pillsbury Music Center on the campus of William Jewell College. Business casual dress for contestants is recommended.

Fee

There will be a \$25.00 performance fee payable to Liberty Symphony Orchestra.

Audition Committee

The audition committee includes the conductor of the Liberty Symphony, or his representative, and one additional judge.

Winners

One winner will be chosen to perform with the Liberty Symphony Orchestra. In the event that there is no winner, there will not be a young artist soloist with the orchestra that season. A \$250 cash award will be presented to the winner at the May 4, 2019 concert. In addition, there will be a significant William Jewell Music Scholarship as long as the winner meets the academic guidelines and continues their music studies.

Availability

The winner must be available for the May 4, 2019, performance and for rehearsals on Tuesday, April 30th (evening) and May 4th (morning).
